Fleck Hall at St. Edward's University is a successful, adaptive re-use of a 1950's era education building. The classroom and hallway renovations honor the structure and finishes of the original building by exposing these surfaces and enhancing them with modern lighting. The top floor is entirely new. It has a full glass façade and sits lightly on the existing building below. Breathtaking views of the campus and city beyond enliven this meeting and reception space.
