## Bluebonnet Electric Cooperative Headquarters

With a cost-effective, hybrid steel and wood structure, dressed in sandstone and glass and nestled in the loblolly pine woods of Bastrop County, the Bluebonnet Electric Cooperative Headquarters building is a sleek, contemporary version of a Texas wilderness lodge. Housing management staff, meeting rooms, and a conference room for the Board of Directors, the headquarters building also includes a Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) center that was designed to withstand flooding, as well as hurricane-force design wind pressures and debris impact loads.
