Two six-story office buildings are flanked by eight-level garage structures with the new Austin City Hall sandwiched between. The rust-colored stacked limestone façade integrates the garage and office buildings into a single visual structure. Cast-in-place flat plate concrete construction in the office buildings allows increased day lighting at the building perimeter and eases coordination of the mechanical systems.
