This small but carefully detailed and artfully crafted pavilion serves as an outdoor learning center and meeting place for Travis Audubon Society at Baker Sanctuary, a 690-acre, mature hardwood juniper woodland habitat for Central Texas' endangered Golden Cheek Warbler. To eliminate any fire hazard due to field welding in this delicate environmental setting, the steel and wood pavilion was designed to be strictly of bolt-together construction. As such, its structural articulation alludes to the common Texas ranch windmill, making the pavilion a comfortable neighbor for the historic Baker Family Cabin nearby.
